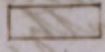



quit Claim to all, that Certain tract of land in said
County, known as one pre-emptive Survey, Beginning
at the South west Corner, of a Survey of 13 Labors, in the
name of Sarah Walker, a water Oak, marked W M, from
which a water Oak, marked +, bears North 1 Vara Runs
North, through timber 573 Varas to the north boundary
line of a Survey, of 600 acres in the name of Nancy
Hobb, a Stake, from which an Elm, marked L, E,
bears S 1 Vara, an ash +, S 30 E, 4 Varas, thence

 in Prescription Book A Page 160 of Hopkins
 Co Records of surveys, as said survey is fraud-
 ulent and void, As said Lindly never
 did make a bona fide, settlement or
 occupy or cultivate any part of same, as
 I shall be able to abundantly prove;
 And I appropriated said land by locating
 thereon on the 12th day of December 1848
 a valid land certificate, to wit, part
 of the theadright Triplicate Certificate
 of Andrew S Young for 3000 acres and
 had the same surveyed and field notes
 returned to the Genl Ld Office and have
 never floated or abandoned the same
 and I claim to be entitled to said
 land by virtue thereof, and am about
 to bring suit against those claiming
 under said Jonathan Lindly survey
 to establish my right thereto
