KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

That Samuel Lindley having served faithfully and honorably in the Army of the Republic of Texas, for the term of 12 Months, from the fourth day of December 1835 until the 16 day of March 1836 and having fallen at the Alamo

is entitled to Six hundred and forty (additional) Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said Samuel Lindley heirs is entitled to hold said Land; or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

In Testimony whereof, I have herunto set my hand, at Austin this third day of December 1847

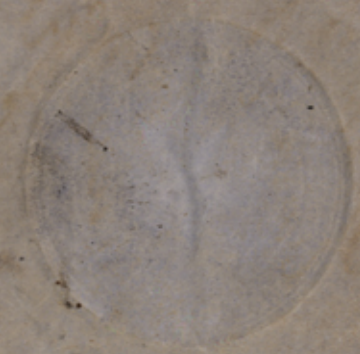
